Dear Parents,

Thank you to Michelle Channels and all of the other parents who helped put together this year's APT Crab Feed last Saturday. The next APT event is the Country Fair, which will be on Saturday, April 26 (please note date change).

For those going to Portland for the Lutheran Elementary School Tournament, please note that there is an informational meeting on Tuesday, February 5 at 7:00 p.m. This is where information packets will be handed out, and it will be a chance to ask questions and coordinate sharing rides to the airport or rental cars. I will also have plane tickets for those traveling with group tickets. If you cannot make this meeting, simply come by the office after February 5 for your packet.

If you or any members of your family are Thrivent members (this means you have a financial product with Thrivent), would you please contact the school office to let us know. Reenrollment begins this coming week. Last week I shared with you the change in how we are collecting reenrollment and comprehensive fees. The reenrollment fees have increased by \$100 per person (\$150.00 per student, due with your form), but the comprehensive fees (that are due in June) will decrease by \$100. This allows us to even these costs out for our families and also ensure more of a commitment at reenrollment. Forms and fees need to be returned no later than February 29<sup>th</sup>. For those students who will be taking the Gesell testing for Kindergarten the fee of \$75.00 is due with your reenrollment. Tuition rates for the 2008-09 school year have not yet been established, but will be soon.

The 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys' basketball team will be traveling to Anaheim Friday to participate in the Zion, Anaheim Basketball Tournament. Please keep the players, coaches and families in your prayers for a safe trip. They will be returning on Monday, February 4<sup>th</sup>.

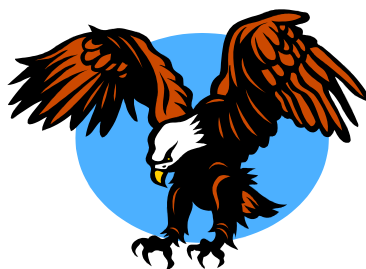
10. **From the Minister of Youth and Children:**
