Dear Parents,

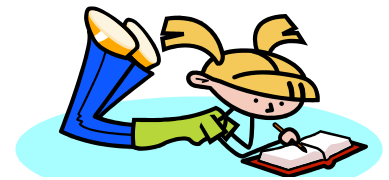
Please keep the students and fans traveling to Portland for the Lutheran Elementary School Tournament in your prayers. Pray for safe travel, health, valuable, and fun experience.

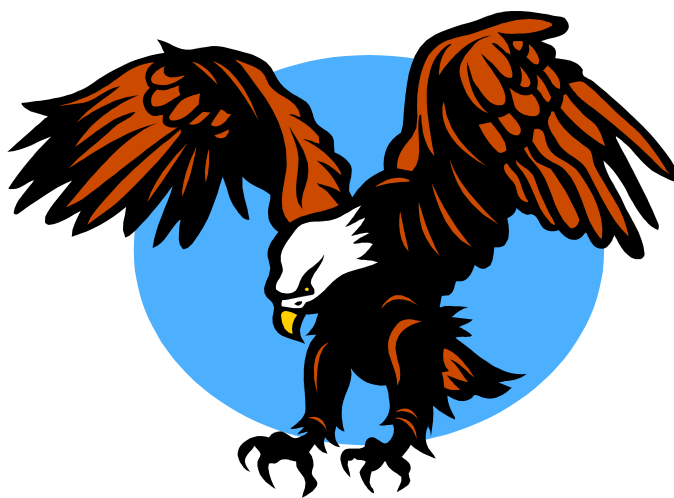
12. **From the Minister of Youth and Children:**
